1. A CHURCH built by Christ. Matthew 16:18; Psalm 127:1
2. A CHURCH named for Christ. Romans 16:16; Isaiah 12:4
3. A CHURCH whose members wear only the name of Christ. Isaiah 62:2; Acts 11:26; 4:12; Ephesians 3:13-14
4. A CHURCH preaching nothing but the gospel of Christ. Mark 16:15-16; Romans 1:16; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9; Hebrews 5:8-9; Galatians 1:6-11
5. A CHURCH preaching as Christ's apostles that FAITH, REPENTANCE, CONFESSION, and BAPTISM are necessary in order to receive forgiveness of alien sins. Hebrews 11:6; Mark 16:15-16; Acts 2:38; Matthew 10:32; Acts 17:30; 22:16; Galatians 3:26-27
6. A CHURCH the Lord himself adds you to when you obey the gospel, not one you can join or be voted into by men. Acts 2:47
7. A CHURCH following Christ and the apostle's teaching in worship. John 4:24; Acts 2:42; Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16; I Corinthians 16:1-2; 11:23-29; Acts 20:7
8. A CHURCH that does not add to, take from, or modify God's commands. 2 Timothy 4:1-4; I Peter 4:11; Revelation 22:18-19
9. A CHURCH that has Christ for her head, her savior, her purchaser, her redeemer, her owner. Ephesians 1:22-23; 5:23-26; Acts 20:28; Matthew 16:18
10. A CHURCH that preaches the truth in love. Ephesians 4:15
11. A CHURCH contending earnestly for the faith once delivered to the saints. Jude 3
12. A CHURCH believing and taking the Bible and the Bible only as it's source of teaching, faith, and practice. 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:3; I Corinthians 4:6
13. A CHURCH teaching and expecting its' members to be faithful, zealous, dedicated, sober, righteous, godly in all manner of living. Revelation 2:19; Romans 12:1-3; Hebrews 12:1-3; Colossians 3:1-25; Galatians 5:16-26; 2 Peter 1:5-12; Hebrews 10:25; Titus 2:11-14
