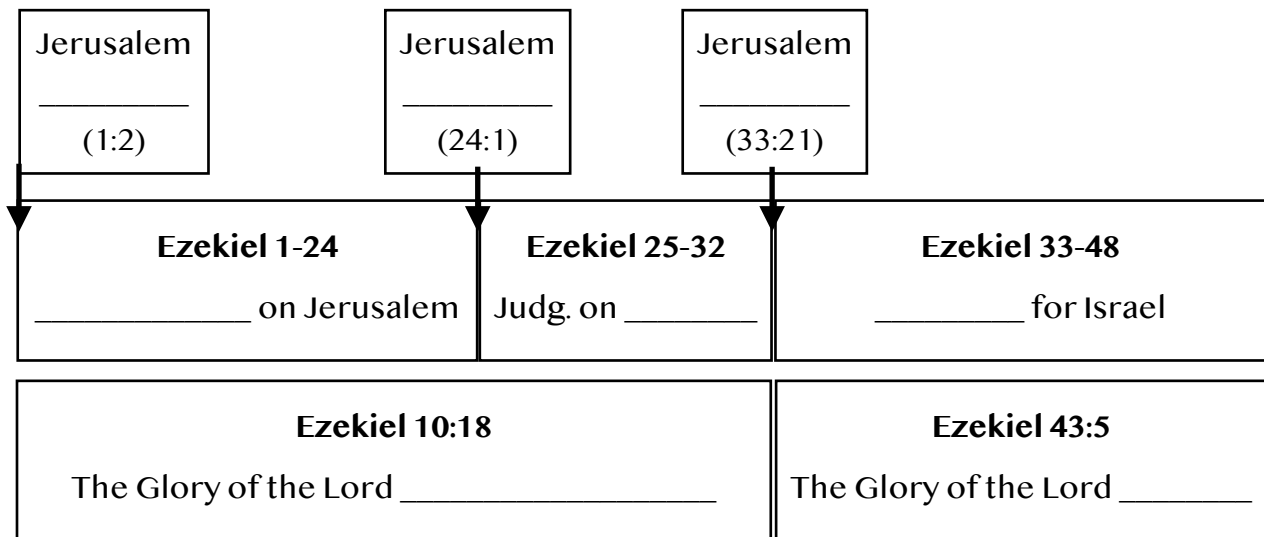


## Class #13 - First Quarter Review
