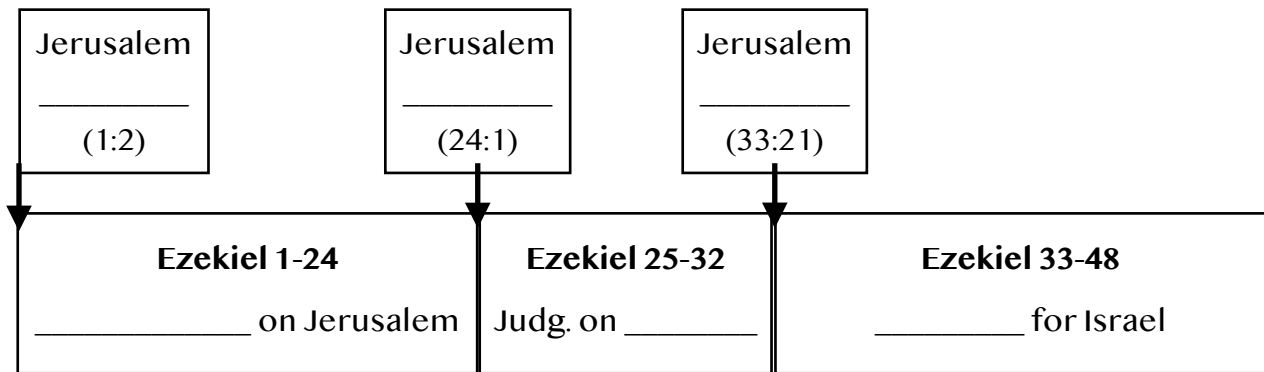


Class #25 - Judgment on the Nations (Ezekiel 25)
